Union Proposals For Negotiations of Contract Term Dec. 1, 2024 - Nov. 30, 2026 for 962-T

- 1. When on-call drive trucks home, same guidelines as linemen
- 2. When on-call, time starts and stops at home
- 3. Clarify non-union and union policies in red
- 4. Update storm protocol: when linemen travel, we travel
- 5. When training is at a remote location, employee will have the option to stay at hotel or travel each day on paid time
- 6. Boot allowance \$300 per year
- 7. Approved time off is locked in
- 8. Clarification on mentor and pay
- 9. Allow dedicated time weekly for progression training
- 10. Ability to use half-hour increments for vacation
- 11. Double time for Sunday work
- 12. Increase in shift differential
- 13. Provide tools and toolbox or offer tool per diem
- 14. When work load requires overtime, employee will be allowed to work flex day first, then Saturday second, and Sunday last.
- 15. Employees will receive a paper copy or email of all shop rules
- 16. Mechanics traveling on storms report to the leadership they are supporting
- 17. Meal guidelines the same as large contract
- 18. GWI

- 4. Supervisor doing bargaining work, diagnosing trucks and ordering parts
- 5. Hiring vs farming out work
